

NENT Group calls 'First Responders' to first original medical drama series

- Ten-part series to premiere exclusively on Viaplay in 2020
- 'First Responders' produced by SF Studios
- NENT Group to premiere at least 20 original productions every year

The Swedish medical drama series 'First Responders' will be the next original production from Nordic Entertainment Group (NENT Group), the Nordic region's leading streaming company. Filmed in the scenic Swedish mountain village of Åre, the 10-part series will premiere exclusively on NENT Group's Viaplay streaming service across the Nordic region in 2020.

'First Responders' (Swedish title: 'Åreakuten') follows the daily lives of hospital, police and rescue personnel in the beautiful yet sometimes hazardous Swedish mountains – where the heady altitudes set the scene for equally dramatic emotional highs and lows.

The series brings together an ensemble Swedish cast featuring Göran Gillinger ('Maria Wern'), Karin Bengtsson ('The Modern Project'), Mårten Svedberg (the 'Johan Falk' series), Nadja Halid ('Senses') and Tiril Wishman Eeg-Henriksen.

'First Responders' is produced by Joakim Hansson (NENT Group's 'The Lawyer') for SF Studios and directed by Lena Koppel ('The Importance of Tying Your Own Shoes') and Richard Jarnhed (NENT Group's 'Black Lake'). Location filming is currently underway in Åre with interior scenes to be shot this autumn.

Recently announced originals include 'Seizure'; 'Partisan'; 'American Runestone'; 'Home Invasion'; 'The Professionals'; 'Fixi in Playland'; 'Shadowplay'; 'Box 21'; season two of 'Rig 45'; 'The Ambassador'; 'Margeaux'; 'Cryptid'; 'Commando'; 'Face to Face'; 'Honour'; 'Love Me'; and 'Cold Courage'.

As well as breaking Nordic viewing records, NENT Group's originals are increasingly reaching audiences around the world. Amongst others, 'ALEX' has been sold to broadcast and streaming partners in <u>Europe</u>, <u>Asia and the US</u>; 'Veni Vidi Vici' has premiered on <u>Hulu</u> and is set for a <u>US remake in partnership with Lionsgate</u>; 'Swedish Dicks' has featured on <u>Pop TV</u> in the US; 'Black Lake' has been shown on <u>BBC Four and AMC Networks-backed Shudder</u>; and the upcoming series '<u>Honour</u>' has been sold to RTL in Germany and to Belgium's VRT.

<u>In January 2019</u>, NENT Group announced a UK-based joint venture with award-winning independent studio FilmNation Entertainment to develop, produce and finance premium scripted television content for global audiences.

In May 2019, NENT Group invested in a minority stake in the new US production company Picturestart together with a range of high-profile industry partners. Based in Los Angeles and founded by renowned producer Erik Feig, Picturestart will create, co-finance and produce premium scripted content for young adult viewers around the world.
