

NENT Group counts in 'Two Sisters' for next original production

- 'Two Sisters' based on Hannah Widell and Amanda Schulman's bestselling novels
- Widell and Schulman are two of Sweden's most high-profile media personalities
- NENT Group to premiere at least 30 original productions in 2020

The next Viaplay Original from Nordic Entertainment Group (NENT Group), the Nordic region's leading streaming company, will be the Swedish drama series 'Two Sisters'. The eight-part show is based on the bestselling novels by Swedish celebrities Hannah Widell and Amanda Schulman and is produced by Yellow Bird ('Millennium'; NENT Group's 'The Truth Will Out'). 'Two Sisters' will premiere exclusively on NENT Group's Viaplay streaming service across the Nordic and Baltic regions in 2021.

From podcasts to blogs to a trilogy of successful novels, Hannah Widell and Amanda Schulman are two of Sweden's most high-profile media personalities. 'Two Sisters' is the first time their books have been adapted into a series. The show explores the diverging lives of young Stockholm siblings Alicia (Dilan Gwyn: NENT Group's 'Love Me') and Vanessa (Julia Ragnarsson: 'My Aunt in Sarajevo') as they climb the career ladder, fall in love and realise that growing up can also mean growing apart.

The series is produced by Alexia Wennberg, Cecilia Forsberg and Georgie Mathew at Yellow Bird, and filming started this week in Stockholm.
