

Viaplay secures Enfusion and Invicta FC fight rights

Based in the Netherlands, Enfusion spans kickboxing and MMA and is renowned for showcasing talents such as Superbon and Andy 'The Destroyer' Souwer. Viaplay will stream over 30 Enfusion, Enfusion Talent and Enfusion Cage Event shows in the Netherlands, Poland and the Baltic countries, starting with Enfusion 105 – Tevette vs. Bchiri on 26 March.
